TODAY'S SCRIPTURE LESSONS:

John 14:1-14

'Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me. ²In God's house there are many dwelling-places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴And you know the way to the place where I am going.' ⁵Thomas said to him, 'Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?' ⁶Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to God except through me. ⁷If you know me, you will know God also. From now on you do know God and have seen God.' ⁸Philip said to him, 'Lord, show us God, and we will be satisfied.' ⁹Jesus said to him, 'Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and you still do not know me? Whoever has seen me has seen God. How can you say, "Show us God"?' ¹⁰Do you not believe that I am in God and God is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own; but God who dwells in me does God's works. ¹¹Believe me that I am in God and God is in me; but if you do not, then believe me because of the works themselves. ¹²Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to God. ¹³I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that God may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴If in my name you ask me for anything, I will do it.
